Rules and Regulations

The following rules are designed to help visitors enjoy their stay. For more information or assistance, please contact any of the park staff or the campground hosts located in the campground.

- Camp only in designated campsites.
- Exceeding registered occupancy may result in a camper having to acquire another site, pay additional camping fees or eviction from the campground. If in doubt, please consult with park staff to determine your needs before you secure only one campsite.
- Only one electrical user is allowed per electric campsite.
- Check-in time is 2PM. Check-out time is 12PM noon following the last night of your stay. Early check-in and late check-out arrangements can be accommodated when available.
- Quiet hours are from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. Please be considerate of your camping neighbors who are seeking a peaceful outdoor experience and keep noise to a reasonable level.
- Solicitation or selling any item (including resale of a campsite) is strictly prohibited without written permission of Spring Branch Park management.
- Cutting firewood in the park is strictly prohibited. Fire wood is provided gratis in the communal fire pits and available for a small charge for private fires.
- Campfires are the responsibility of the camper and are restricted to approved fire rings, fire pits or charcoal grills. Open fires, in any form, must not infringe on adjacent sites.
- Burning trash in the fire ring, fire pit or charcoal grill is strictly prohibited.
- The discharging of firearms, BB guns, paintball guns, bow and arrows, sling shots or any devices that use burning powder, explosives, compressed gases, etc. is prohibited, unless participating in an organized campground event.
- Please place trash in trash receptacles provided. Trash and trash bags in your campsite will be sufficient cause for immediate eviction.
- Pets must be kept under control at all times. Aggressive or annoying animals must be kept leashed at all times. The use of a shock collar or other electronic device does not meet these requirements. Use of pet waste bags is strongly encouraged and available at each trash receptacle location.
- Trenching around tents, littering, or discharging sewage or gray water on the ground is prohibited.
- Do not pick or dig up plants, disturb or feed animals.
- Golf carts, ATV's and utility vehicles are allowed in the park but no motorized vehicles in, across, or north of the creek. SBP reserves the right to restrict use of any vehicle in the park and will do so if management determines that use of that vehicle is detrimental to other campers or grounds, including roads.
